Department Profile:

UK's largest cardiothoracic centre with nearly all specialist cardiac services for North Central and North East London and beyond, as well as highly specialised national services. Anaesthetic trainees rotating to Barts are exposed to most aspects of cardiothoracic anaesthesia and intensive care excluding transplantation. Most trainees rotate here for three months at intermediate and higher levels but there are plans to try to create 6 month posts in the future. We undertake \sim 2000 cardiac cases per annum (CABG, valve replacements & repairs (including minimal access surgery), complex aortic surgery (including dissections) and adult congenital surgery); 1200 thoracic cases (including robotic assisted and other minimal access surgery); we have the biggest TAVI programme in the UK with 350 - 400 implants a year; and the largest EP service in Europe (~4000 cases per year with around 500 requiring general anaesthesia). We also have one of the busiest heart-attack centres in the UK.
