The Department of Anaesthesiology and Intensive Care at the University of Leipzig Medical Center provides anaesthesia care for more than 27,000 patients annually. Except for cardiac surgery, we cover the full range of clinical services including neonatal/paediatric surgery as well as kidney and liver transplantation. The 50+ bed multidisciplinary surgical ICU is not only led by our department but also provides the full spectrum of intensive care including ECMO therapy. Exchange trainees will be given the opportunity to observe, immerse and learn in all anaesthesia and intensive care services of the department.
