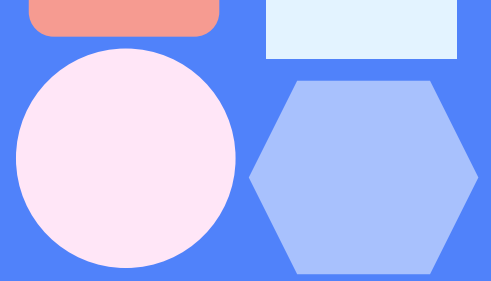

The Department provides anaesthesia for high-acuity procedures, including major vascular surgery and polytrauma. Clinical expertise extends to hepato-pancreato-biliary, general, and colorectal surgery, as well as urological, orthopaedic, obstetric, and gynaecological operations. In addition, the Department offers comprehensive pain management services, including acute pain control, perioperative analgesia, and multidisciplinary care for patients with chronic pain.

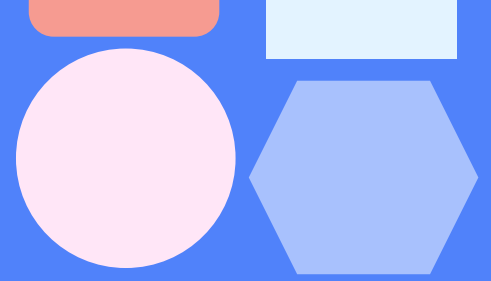

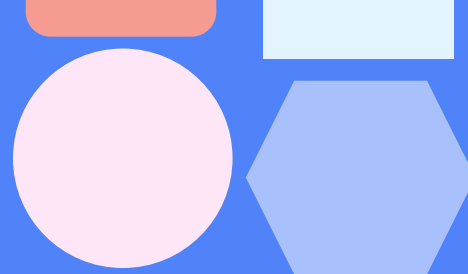
