Varese is located in the north of Italy, north of Lombardia area, in the middle of lakes region, near the Swiss border and it is livable garden town of 80.000 people. Our hospital has 550 beds which take care of a large population of patients both from north west of Lombardia and Piemonte, in a particularly industrialized area, very near to Milan Malpensa International airport. Our

Emergency Care Dept. is composed by Emergency Room (8 ICU beds), general ICU (12 beds), Trauma ICU (8 beds), Neuro ICU (8 beds), Cardiac ICU (8 in UTIC and 6 in post-Cardiac Surgery). Furthermore, Varese is a Trauma

Centre serving Lombardia area, it is inserted in a very efficient extra-hospital emergency system. We received patients with different time-dependent pathologies (overall 700 patients year in all the ICU). The fellow will have the opportunity to manage very critically ill patients together with an exciting experience in our research clinical activities. Each fellow will be followed personally by a tutor and may take part in one of our research projects.
