

## ESAIC Research endorsement request – Eligibility criteria

This document outlines the eligibility requirements for applicants seeking ESAIC endorsement for research projects.

The endorsement request form should contain between 1,200 and 1,500 words and must be submitted prior to the specified deadline.

The endorsement includes:

- Use of the ESAIC logo and the sentence 'Endorsed by ESAIC'.
- Promotion on a section of the ESAIC website

### **Type of Study**

To be eligible, projects must align with ESAIC's commitment to advancing anaesthesiology and intensive care and must be prospective and multicentre studies. Please note that surveys are not eligible.

### **ESAIC Membership**

The main applicant must be an active ESAIC member at the time of application.

### **When to ask for endorsement**

The research project must be planned or ongoing and not completed or even published at the time of submission for endorsement.

### **Follow-Up and Reporting**

All abstracts, presentations and publications resulting from Endorsement must acknowledge the European Society of Anaesthesiology and Intensive Care (ESAIC) in the abstract and/or acknowledgement section.

The applicant is required to submit the final publication to ESAIC once it becomes available. ESAIC may send a yearly reminder to ensure timely submission of the publication. It is requested to add the assigned ESAIC Tracking ID **ESAIC\_ENDORSEMENT** in the acknowledgement section of the publication.

Please note that, if the application is accepted for the endorsement, the logo should be used in a non-prominent way, preferably at the bottom of documents or websites and font and style should always be respected.
