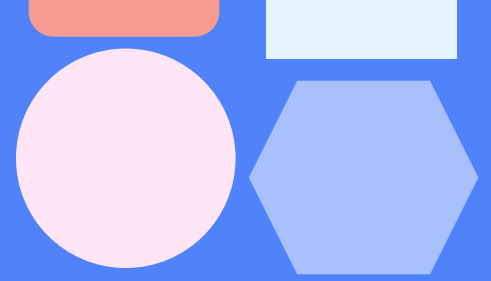

Our service consists of more than 80 specialists. We also have 32 anaesthesiology residents and receive 10 external residents from other communities to train with us in different sections. We are a 3rd level hospital so we offer all surgical specialities including liver, cardiac and renal transplants. We are a reference centre for neurocritical patients at both surgical and intensive care levels. We are also a reference centre for polytrauma patients.
