Department Profile:

Gazi University was founded 100 years ago but Faculty of Medicine started to teach medical students in 1979. Gazi University Hospital has a TS-EN ISO 9001 Quality Assurance System Certificate since 1998. Our Anaesthesiology and Intensive Care education has become accredited by ESAIC in 2018 and then re-accredited in 2023 until 2028.

Our hospital has 906 bed capacity, ICU-Reanimation Unit has 12 beds, PACU has 6 beds, 23 central operating rooms (OR) in addition to 8 remote OR (3 OR for Cardiovascular and thoracic surgery + 2 OR for Obstetrics with 3 labour-delivery rooms plus 3 OR for outpatient surgery which are equipped with modern technology to teach trainees anaesthesiology practice (general anesthesia, central and peripheral blocks under USG guidance assisted with without AI) for all types of surgery. During rotations of the trainees to each surgery and outpatient units (endoscopy, interventional radiology and other imaging technology units etc.), both basic and specific teaching skills such as ultrasound guided invasive procedures (IV, arterial or central access establishments) or peripheral/plane blocks supported by AI, awake craniotomies, epidural labour analgesia are taught to eligible trainees based on the predefined curriculum to improve their performance by the faculty members. As of today, total number of trainees are 50 and actively working faculty member number is 30 in our department who are responsible for practical and theoretical training/education of all trainees during working hours. Each faculty member has to supervise at least 2 trainees graduation thesis. During academic calendar (from October till June), each faculty member (with or without company of the designated trainee) is responsible to present one seminar on every Fridays (between 8.00 am-9.00 am) and journal club every Wednesdays (between 7.30 am-8.00 am). Trainees are encouraged to attend annual meetings of international/national anaesthesiology society to present their works and subsequently publish them in peer review journals under guidance of their supervisors. The hospital is equipped with "Nucleus" computer system program to provide online access to medical records, laboratory results, images, consultation reports and history of all the previously admitted patients and new admissions. Desktop computers are available in every operating room and for all the faculty/staff/personnel/secretary. Anaesthesiology Department of Gazi University Hospital which is a modern QA-certified tertiary referral center with 70,000 case load (operations) in one year offers not only education in terms of practice and scientific perspective for students and trainees in medicine but also provides high quality service for patients in the capital city of the country
