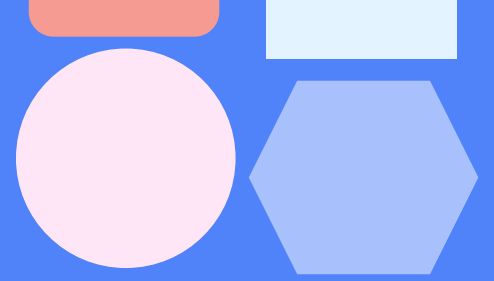

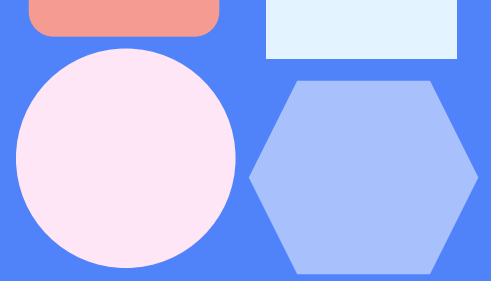

### Department Profile:

Koç University Department of Anesthesiology and Reanimation provides education in anesthesiology, intensive care and postoperative pain management. The center currently involves the education of 10 residents in anesthesiology and 1 fellow in intensive care. Koç University Hospital with 550 total bed capacity including Reanimation Unit (16 beds), PACU (70 beds) and 23 central operating rooms are equipped with modern technology to teach trainees anaesthesiology practice (general anaesthesia, central and peripheral blocks) for all types of surgery. As of today, the total number of actively working faculty members is 6 in the Department of Anaesthesiology & Reanimation 4 professors and 3 associate professors, 3 academic attending staff.

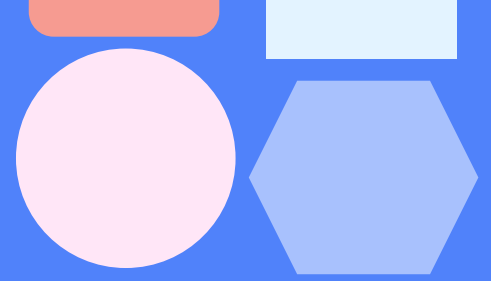

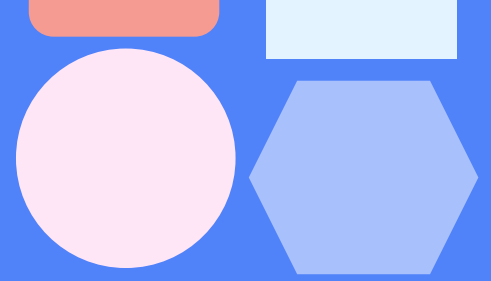

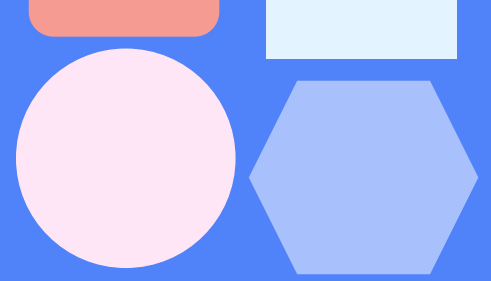
