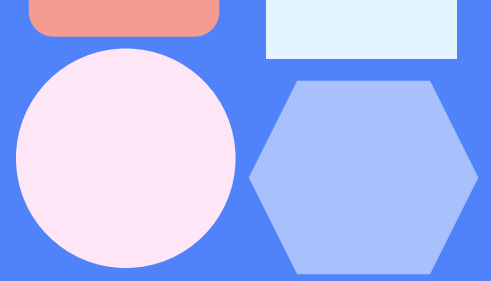

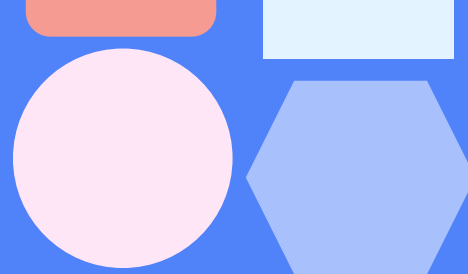

Department Profile:

The Department of Anaesthesiology, Perioperative and Intensive Care Medicine provides comprehensive anaesthesia and critical care across all specialties at Masaryk Hospital, in close cooperation with cardiology, cardiac surgery, and infectious diseases. Accredited by ATAIC in 2023, the department has operated from modern facilities since 2024, featuring a 20-bed ICU (including 16 high-dependency beds), a separate PACU, 18 operating theatres including a hybrid suite, and extensive out-of-theatre anaesthesia. We excel in neuroanaesthesia, regional anaesthesia, trauma care, thoracic and paediatric anaesthesia, and support critical interventions such as ECMO.

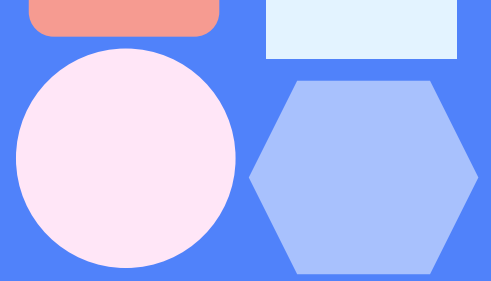

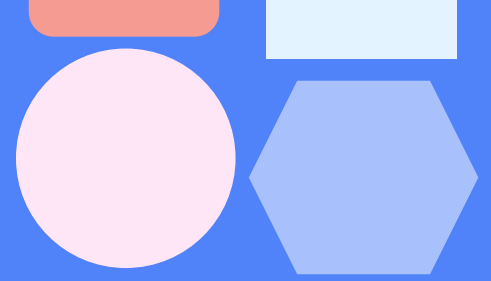

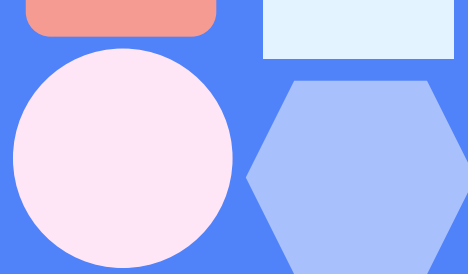
