Department Profile:

The department is structured with operating rooms for every specialty, general surgery, obstetrics, neurosurgery, cardiac surgery, thoracic, urology, plastic, ophthalmologic, rhino- otolaryngology, pediatric surgery, bariatric and robotic surgery. There are two mixed ICUs for a total of 16 beds (included a pediatric one). We are trauma center and receive patients from the north of Puglia and neighboring. Since the first year of post graduate, residents turn different OR and ICU setting, with varieties of skills and duties based on their carrier, in association with some months available to spend abroad for cardiac surgery. They do have lectures and simulation course at SiMUMed (the simulation lab of University of Foggia), Journal Clubs and the possibility to carry on research projects on their own with the supervision of one member of the Academic Staff.
