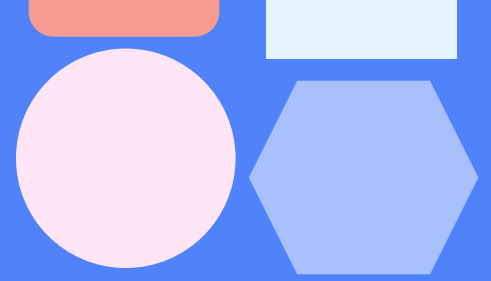

Department Profile:

The Department is a full university department. Located on 4 primary clinical facilities with three ICUs and two IMCUs. The University Department is comprised of 101 anaesthesiologist faculty members (including fellows), including 37 senior staff members, 115 residents in training, anaesthesia and an administrative support staff. Collectively, the department operates approximately 34 operating rooms and multiple NORA (Non-Operating Room Anesthesia) locations per day in all subspecialty areas of anaesthesia. Approximately 30,000 anaesthetic procedures are performed annually in the department. Our team are treating about 3500 critical ill patients per year on all departmental ICUs and IMCUs. The department is heavily committed to undergraduate and postgraduate medical education and teaching at the University of Münster. With our concept of competency-based medical education (CBME) we offer our residents a structured curriculum, feedback and rotations to optimize their learning experience. We also offer fellowship opportunities for anesthesiologists seeking additional sub-specialty training in cardiothoracic-, and pediatric anesthesia. In addition, the Department has a very active research division. During the last decades, our research team has developed successful research programs within the department, recognized nationally and internationally. These research programs have attracted peer-reviewed research grants from multiple organizations.
